What are we looking for?

We are currently looking to appoint a Senior Engineer, Cloud Infrastructure will assist with the design, implementation, and management of our Azure cloud infrastructure and associated M365 environments.

This is a hybrid delivery/operations role working within a larger cross-functional team to ensure the reliability, scalability, and security of our cloud-based systems and to ensure that the designs and implementation conducted by our various delivery partners are to a high-quality standard.

The role's principal accountabilities will be in:

- Design, deploy, and maintain Azure infrastructure components including virtual networks, storage accounts, virtual machines, database instances.
- Implement and manage Azure services such as virtual machines, app services & gateways, SQL & PostgreSQL databases, APIM, Azure AD app registrations and security integrations.
- Implement and manage M365 tenants and applications including Exchange, Teams, and SharePoint
- Collaborate with development and operations teams to deploy applications and services on Azure using Azure DevOps (YAML, Terraform, ARM) tools.
- Implement and enforce security best practices, including identity and access management, network security, and data encryption.
- Develop and maintain documentation related to infrastructure architecture, configuration, and procedures.
- Troubleshoot and resolve infrastructure issues, ensuring high availability and disaster recovery capabilities.

You will have...

- Demonstrable experience in designing, implementing, and managing Azure Cloud Infrastructure.
- Extensive experience of designing, implementing and operating Windows technology solutions in the enterprise including AD DS, PKI, Conditional Access, Software Packaging and Deployment (SCCM & Intune), SQL Server, Exchange, SharePoint
- Advanced proficiency with infrastructure-as-code tooling including Terraform and ARM templates.
- Advanced knowledge of Azure services and components.
- Advanced knowledge of enterprise network and security technologies.
- Advanced proficiency with scripting languages such as PowerShell or Azure CLI.
- Strong critical thinking skills and ability to troubleshoot complex infrastructure issues.
- Ability to organise own time and be effective at managing time and priorities across multiple, sometimes competing, projects.
- Ability to work effectively in cross-functional teams and communicate technical concepts to non-technical stakeholders.
